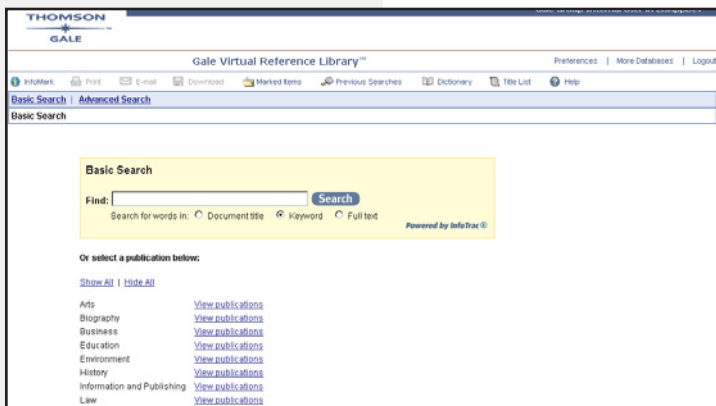

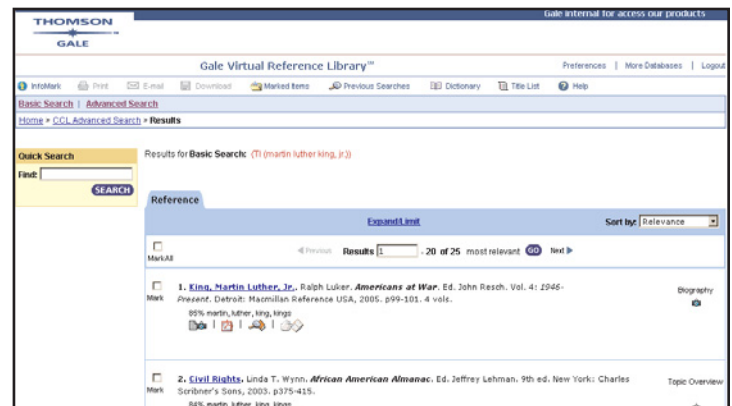

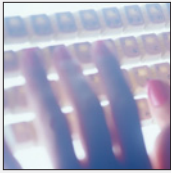

SEARCHING MADE SIMPLE

Gale Virtual Reference Library's basic search functionality is simple to use — researchers find terms through a keyword search, by article title or in the full text. For research that requires a more advanced search, *Gale Virtual Reference Library* supports searches that combine criteria by:

- Title
- Keyword
- Image captions
- Publisher
- Author
- Full text
- Publications
- ISBN
- Starting page

Need to further refine your search? You can limit results of your *Gale Virtual Reference Library* search by source or by publication date; select from a subject list of all disciplines in your collection; or focus on reference directed at children's or general audience reading levels. With cross-title searching, you may browse a list of all eBook sources in your collection and select up to 10 to add to your search query. Results are delivered at the article level (not a page at a time) in an HTML-based text and graphics format that's designed for speedy display and easy readability. With single-click ease, articles can be printed, e-mailed or displayed as PDF page layouts.
